## COVID-19 QUARANTINE GUIDANCE UPDATE

### April 19, 2021

#### **General Quarantine Guidance**

Close contacts to suspected or confirmed COVID-19 cases may discontinue quarantine after Day 10 without testing if asymptomatic, with some exceptions (see [Health Advisory: updated COVID-19 quarantine guidelines from December 15, 2020](#)).

#### **Quarantine Guidance for Fully Vaccinated Individuals**

Fully vaccinated individuals with an exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 are **NOT** required to quarantine if they meet **ALL** of the following criteria:

- Are fully vaccinated (i.e.,  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine)
- Have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID-19 exposure


#### **Cal/OSHA Quarantine Guidance for Workplaces**
