



Regional Stay at Home Order

In regions with less than 15% ICU availability, the Regional Stay Home Order will go into effect within 48 hours. When the Stay Home Order is triggered, residents of the region must stay home as much as possible except to access critical services and allows for many outdoor activities for physical and mental health. This limited closure will help stop the surge and prevent overwhelming regional ICU capacity.

Once the order is activated, it remains in effect for at least 3 weeks and, after that period, will be lifted when a region's projected ICU capacity meets or exceeds 15%.

The following sectors must close:

- Indoor recreational facilities
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Personal care services
- Museums, zoos, and aquariums
- Movie theaters
- Bars, breweries, distilleries, wineries
- Family entertainment centers
- Cardrooms and satellite wagering
- Limited services
- Live audience sports
- Amusement parks

These sectors are allowed to remain open when a remote option is not possible with infectious disease preventative measures and 100% masking and physical distancing:

- Critical infrastructure
- Schools that are already open for in-person learning
- Non-urgent medical and dental care
- Child care and pre-K
- Medical and dental care

These sectors will have additional modifications and 100% masking and physical distancing:

- Outdoor recreational facility operation allowed without any food, drink or alcohol sales. No overnight campground stays.
- Retail/Shopping Center indoor operation allowed at 20% capacity (entrance metering; no eating/drinking in locations). Add special hours for seniors and others with health risks.
- Grocery store operation allowed at 35% capacity
- Hotels and lodging allow to open for critical infrastructure support only.
- Restaurant operation allows only take-out, pick-up, or delivery.
- Offices to allow remote only except for critical infrastructure sectors where remote working is not possible.
- Places of worship are allowed for outdoor services at 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer.
- Political expression is allowed for outdoor services only.
- Gyms are allowed for outdoor operations only.
- Entertainment production/professional sports: Allowed without live audiences. Add testing protocol and highly encourage "bubbles".
- Outdoor playgrounds and school playgrounds remain open
