

# Water Restrictions in Sacramento County



## Why are there different water restrictions for water providers?

The State has mandated conservation levels based on a water agency's per capita water use. The higher the per capita water use, the higher the conservation requirement.



## How do I find out who my water provider is?

## How much do I have to reduce?

Each provider has a different reduction requirement depending on their state mandate.



## Who do I call about my water restrictions and possible incentive programs? (Such as Cash for Grass)

Call your water provider directly for information that pertains to your location.

# Water Restrictions



## Will I have to reduce even more if I've already been reducing?

Your water use will be compared to 2013 usage levels, so this requirement is **not** in addition to what you conserved last year.

## Will I be fined if I don't reduce?

Water providers generally want to educate and provide incentives for conservation. But if you do not make the necessary changes, water providers and some municipalities will conduct enforcement.

Each provider will be reporting their enforcement numbers to the State Water Resources Control Board.



## Who do I call to report water waste?

Call your water provider but if you're not sure, you can call Sacramento County at 311 or 875-4311.

## What information do I need to report water waste?

The days/times of the water waste, description of the issue and the address. Your name and number is optional, but preferred in case clarification is needed.
